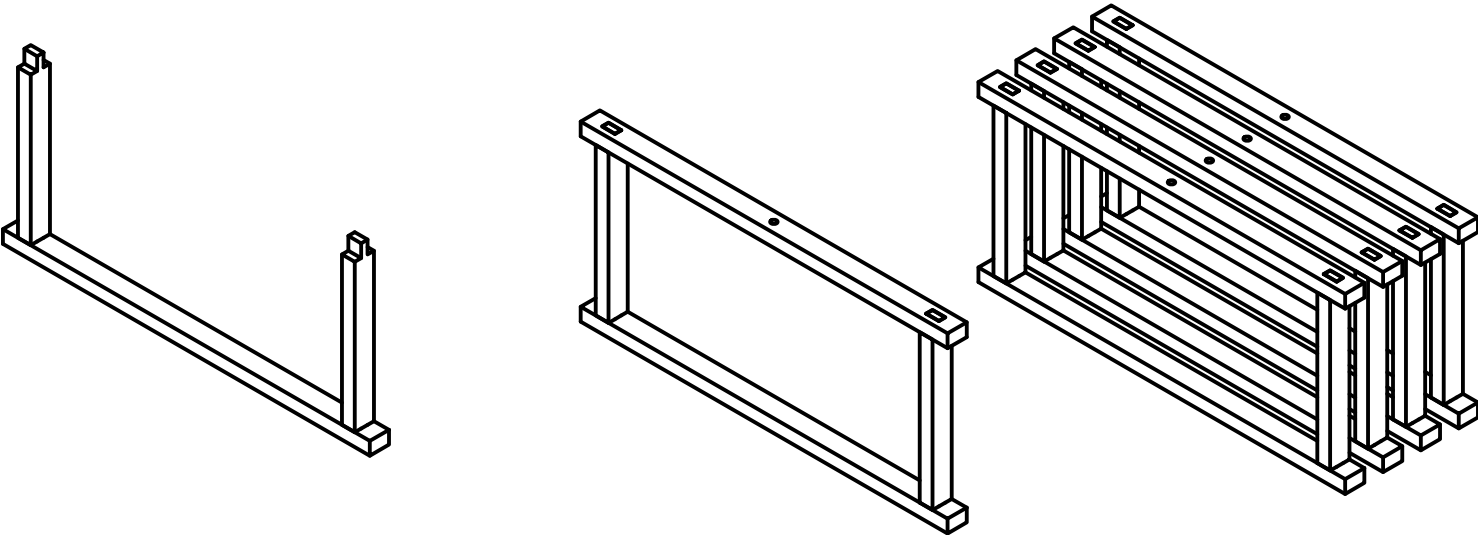
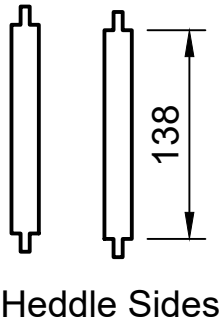
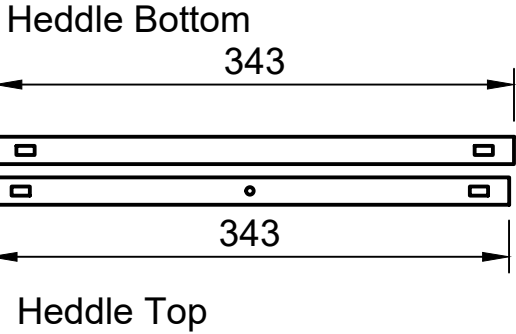
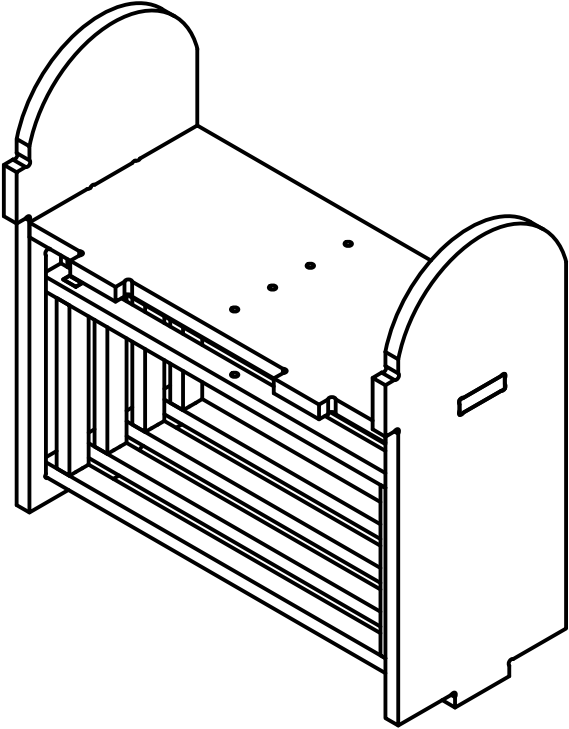
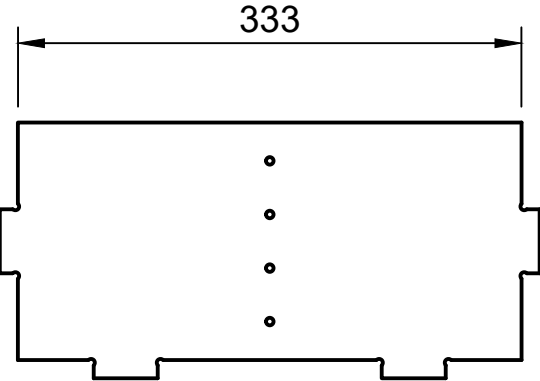
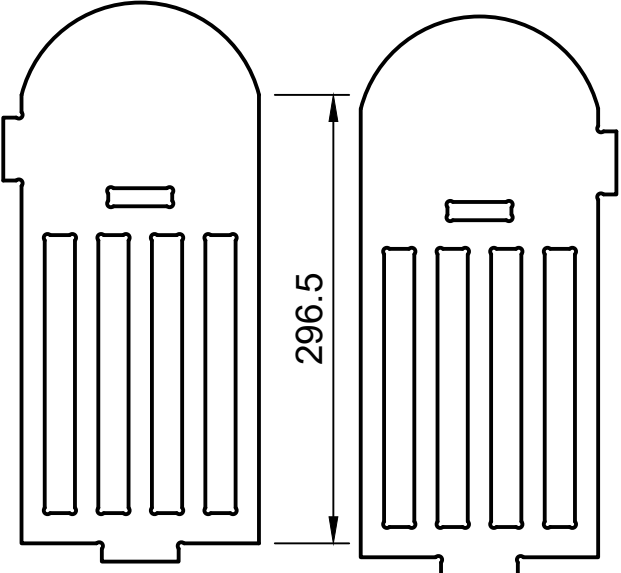


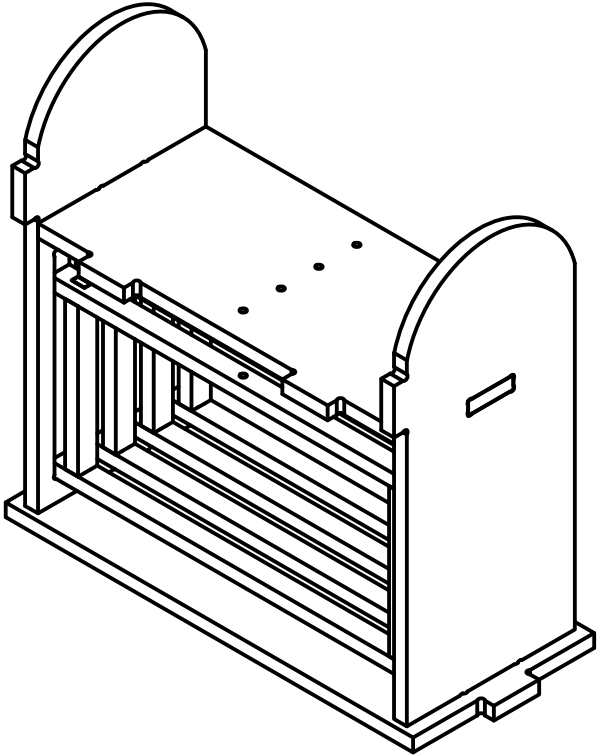
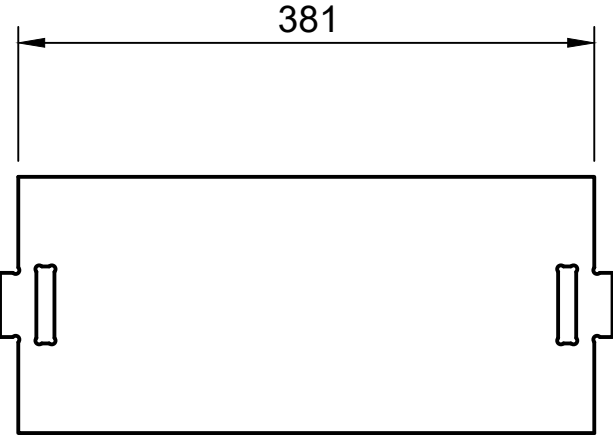
Step 1: Arrange the heddle sides on the bottom and close with the tops to make a set. There are four heddle sets.



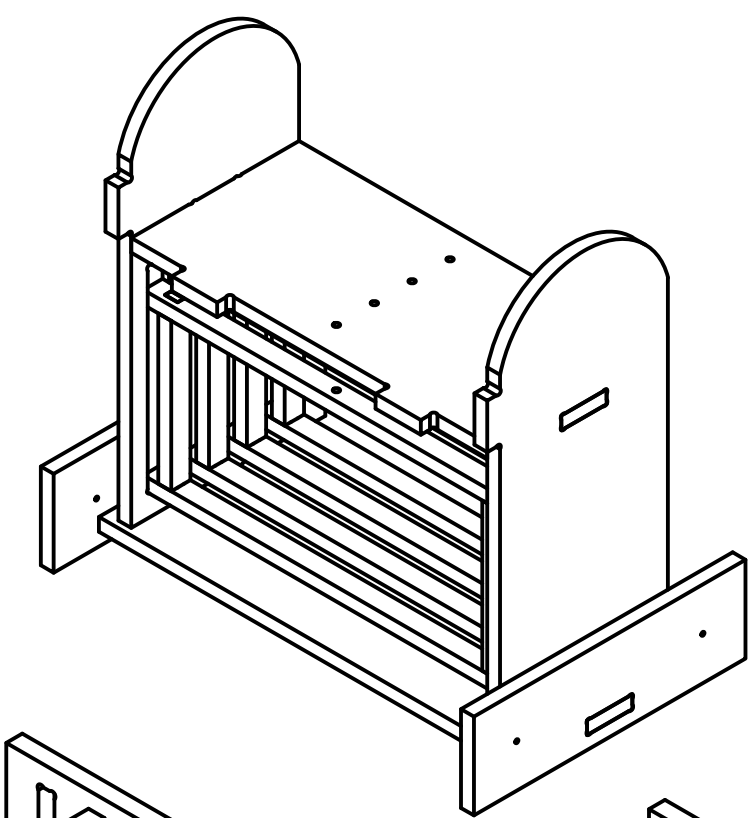
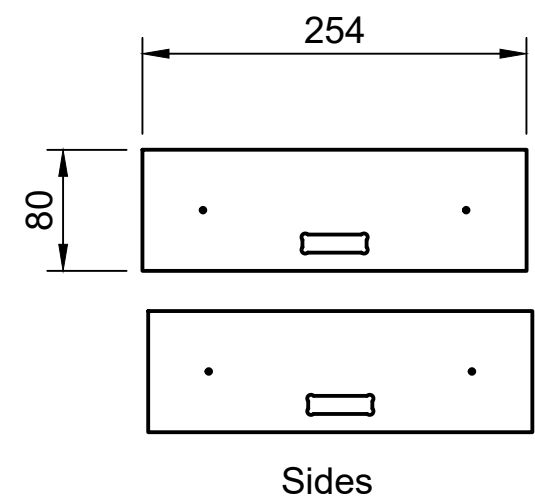
Step 2: Place the Castle Top and the four heddles on the slots given on the Castle sides. The heddles need to freely move up and down once assembled.



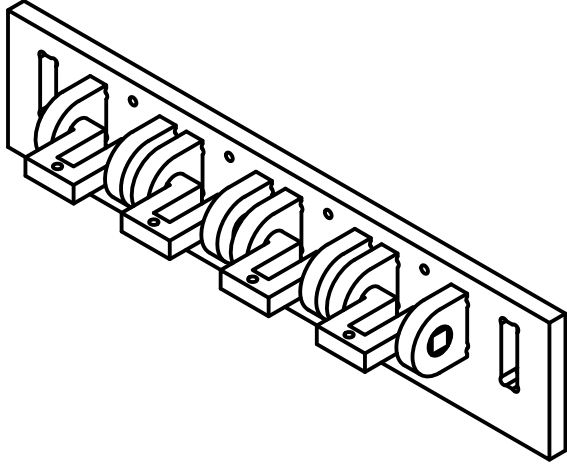
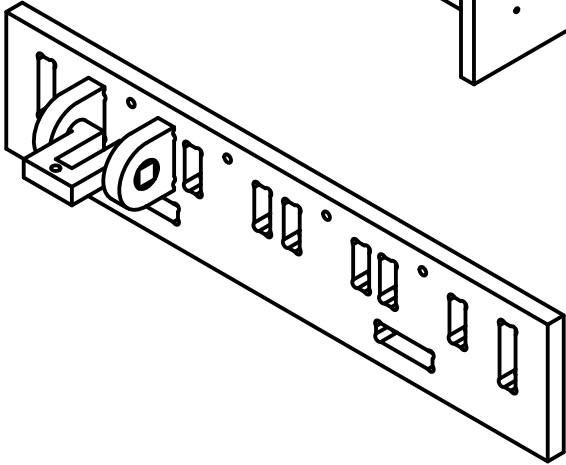
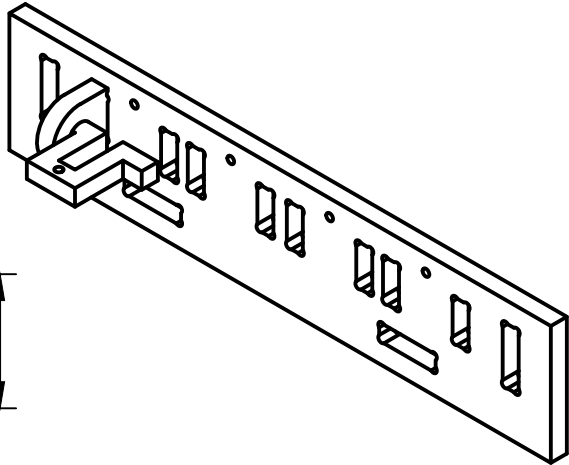
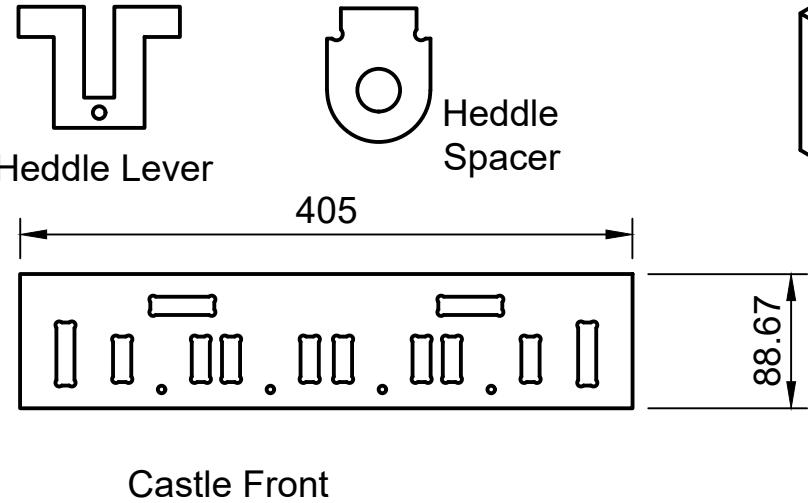
Step 3: Connect the base to the Castle on the slots given.



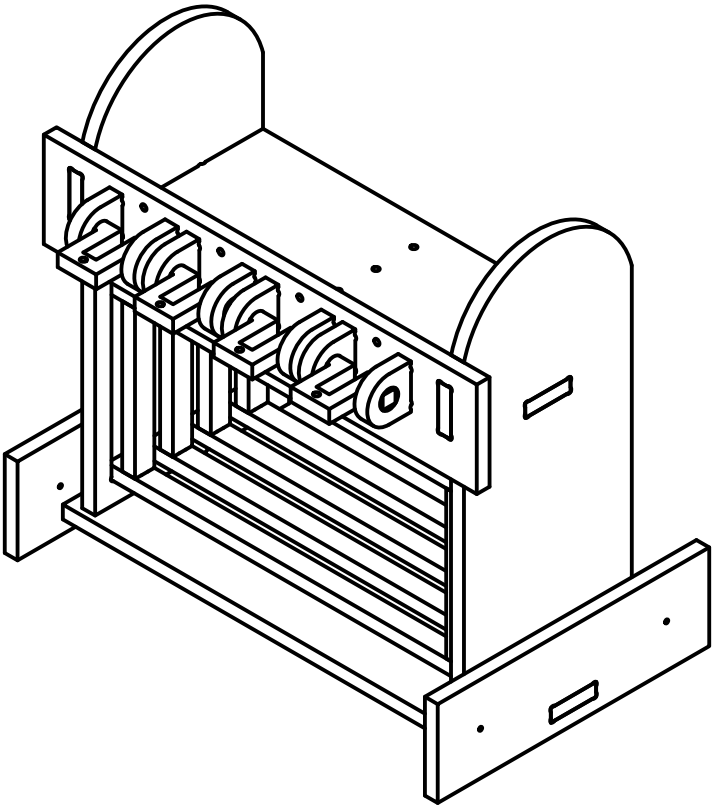
Step 4: Connect the sides to the Base

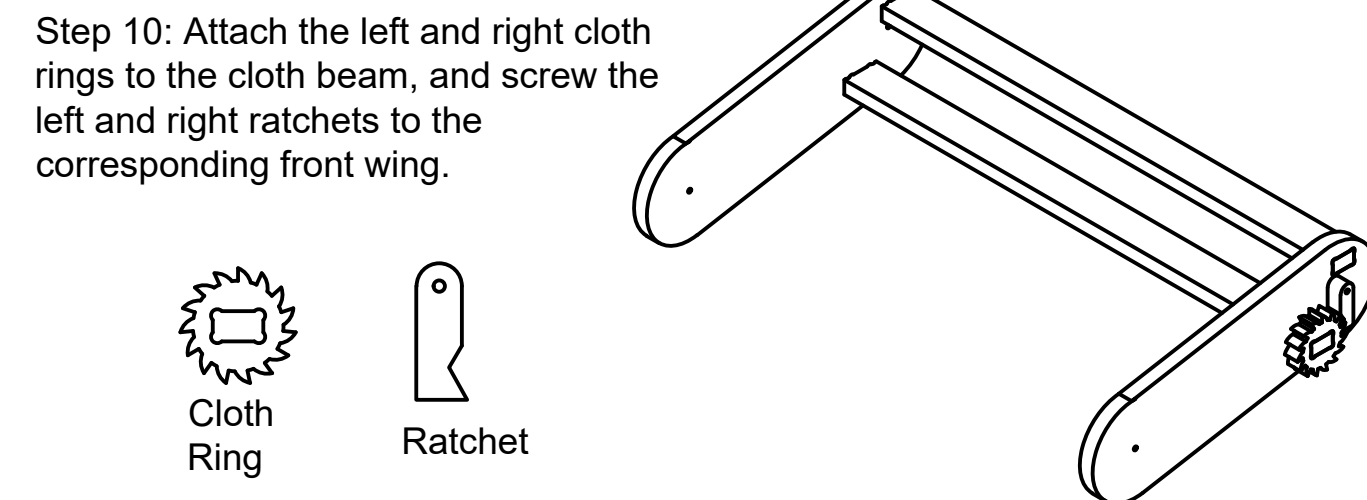
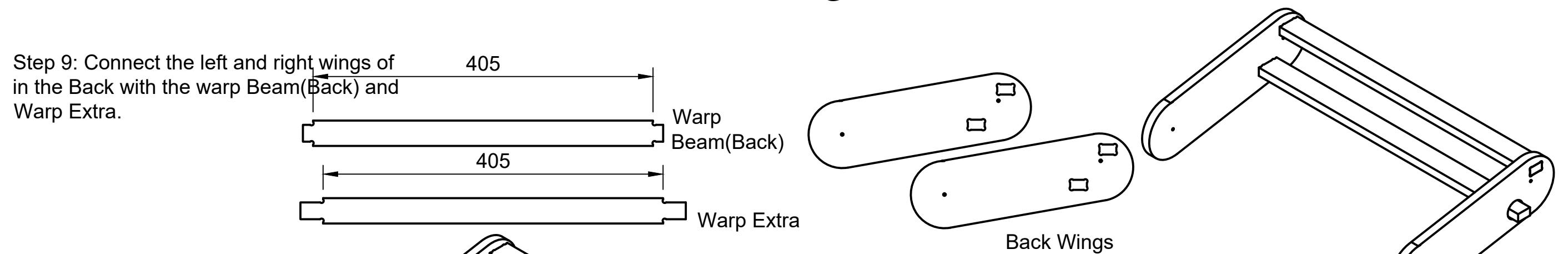
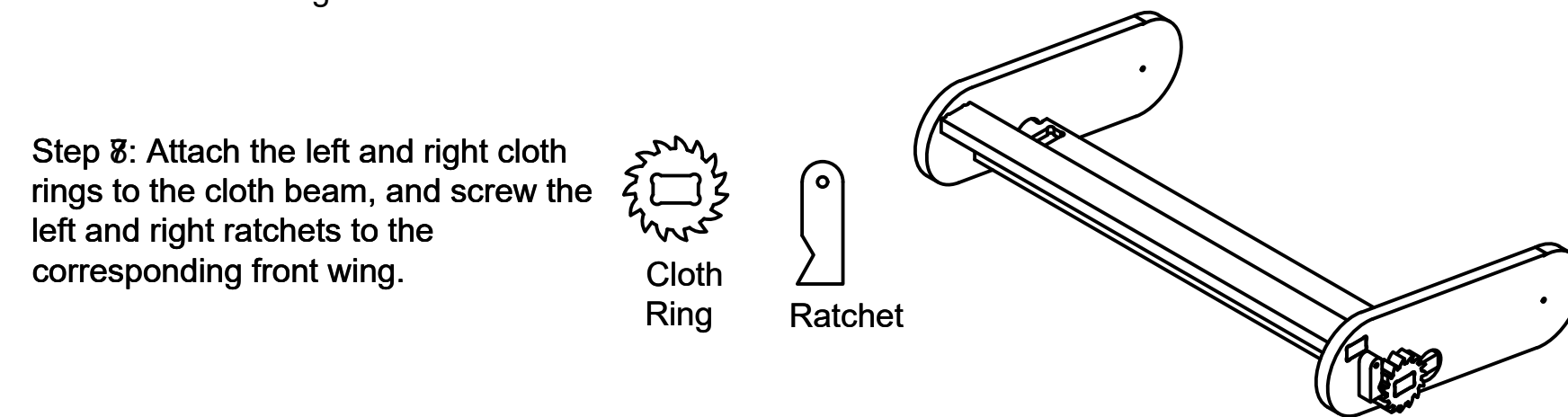
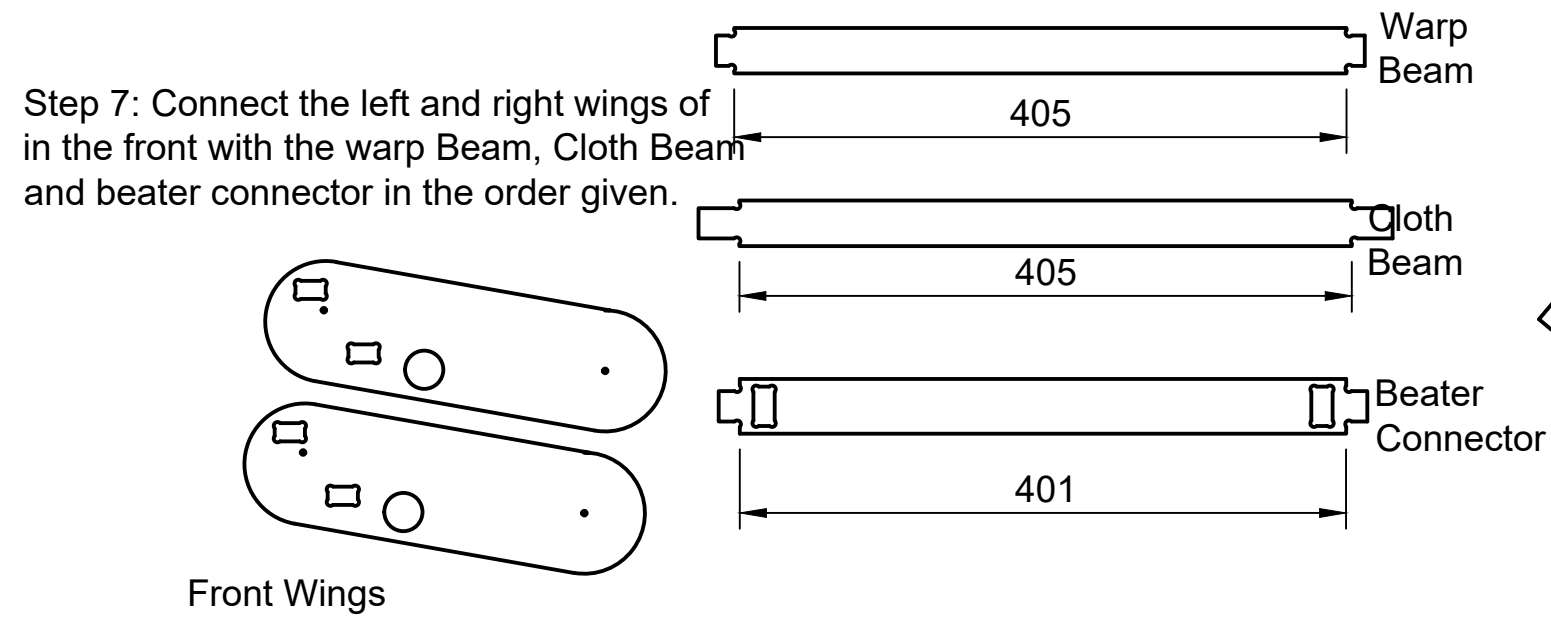


Step 5: Connect the Heddle Spacer and Heddle Lever to the slots given on the Castle Front

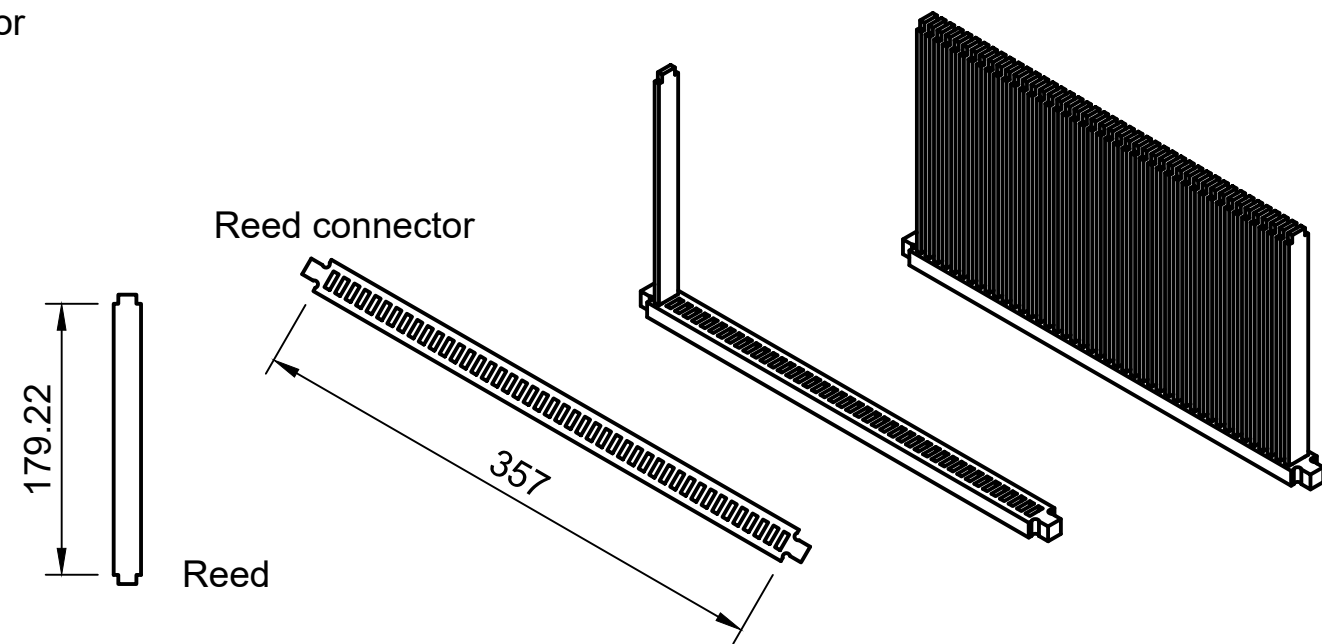


Step 6: Attach the castle front to the slots on the Castle Sides.

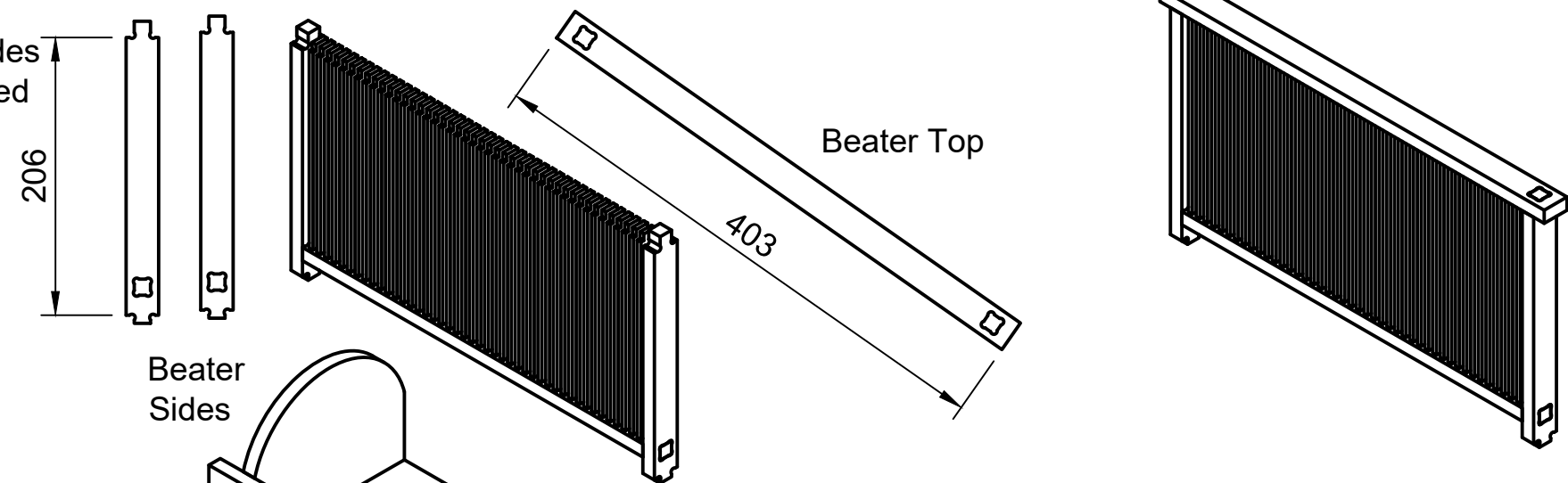




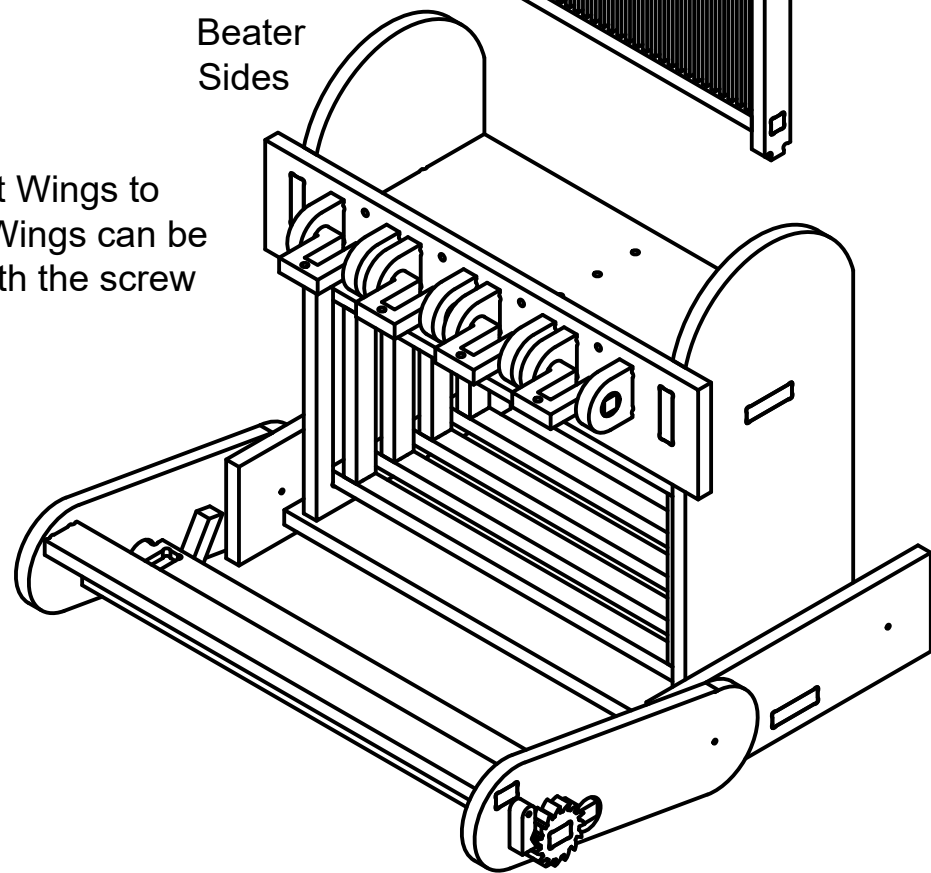
Step 11: Connect the reeds to the reed conector



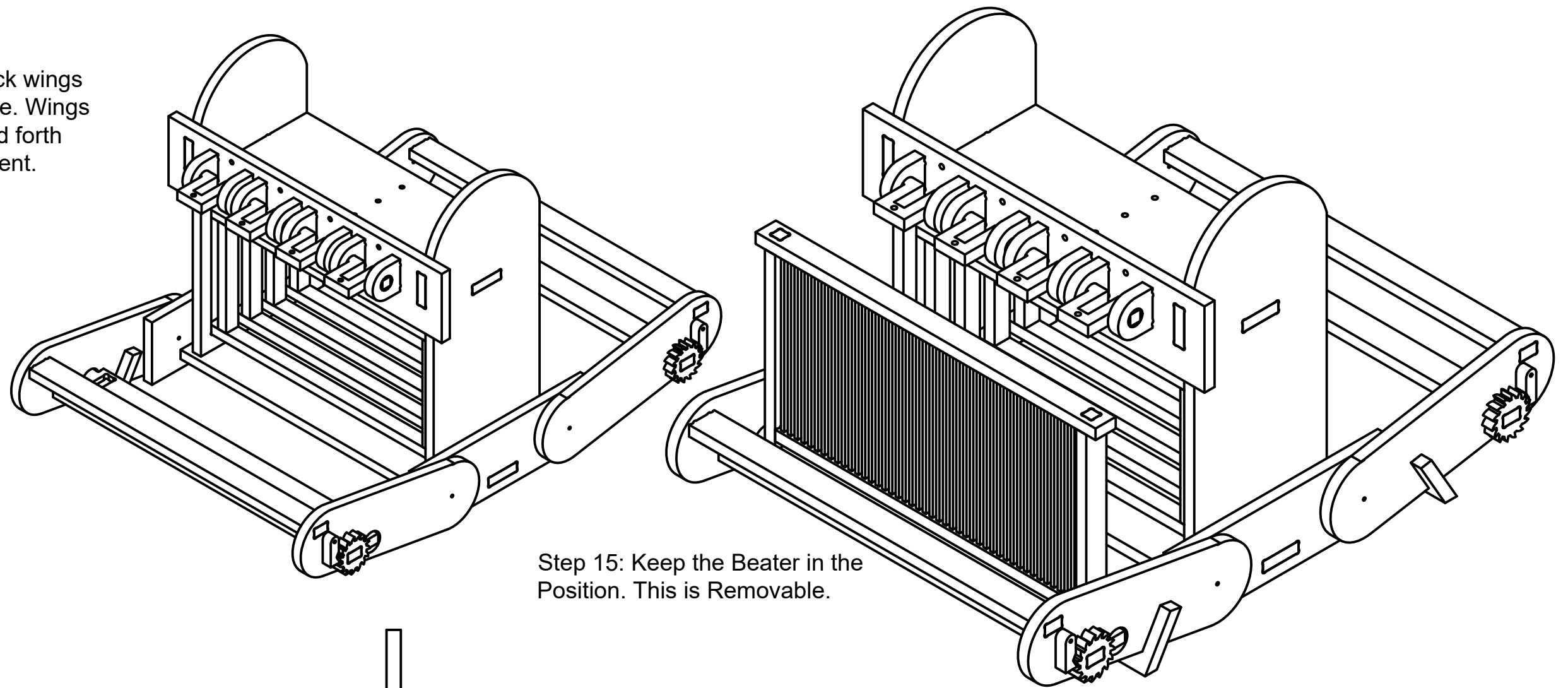
Step 12: Attach the Beater sides and the Beater Top to the Reed Connector and Reeds



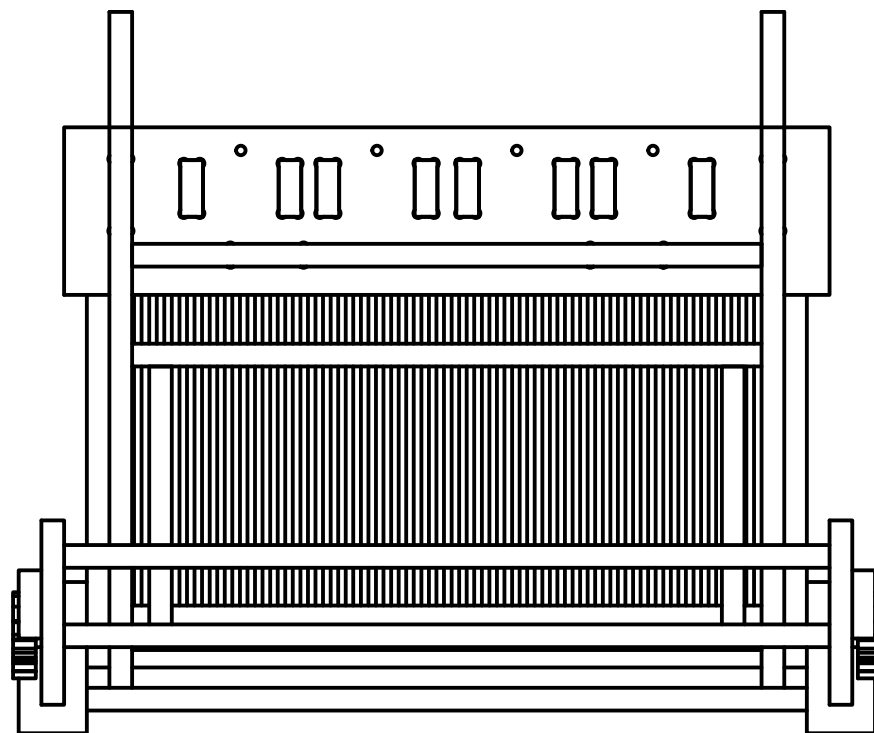
Step 13: Screw the Front Wings to the sides of the Castle. Wings can be moved back and forth with the screw adjustment.
